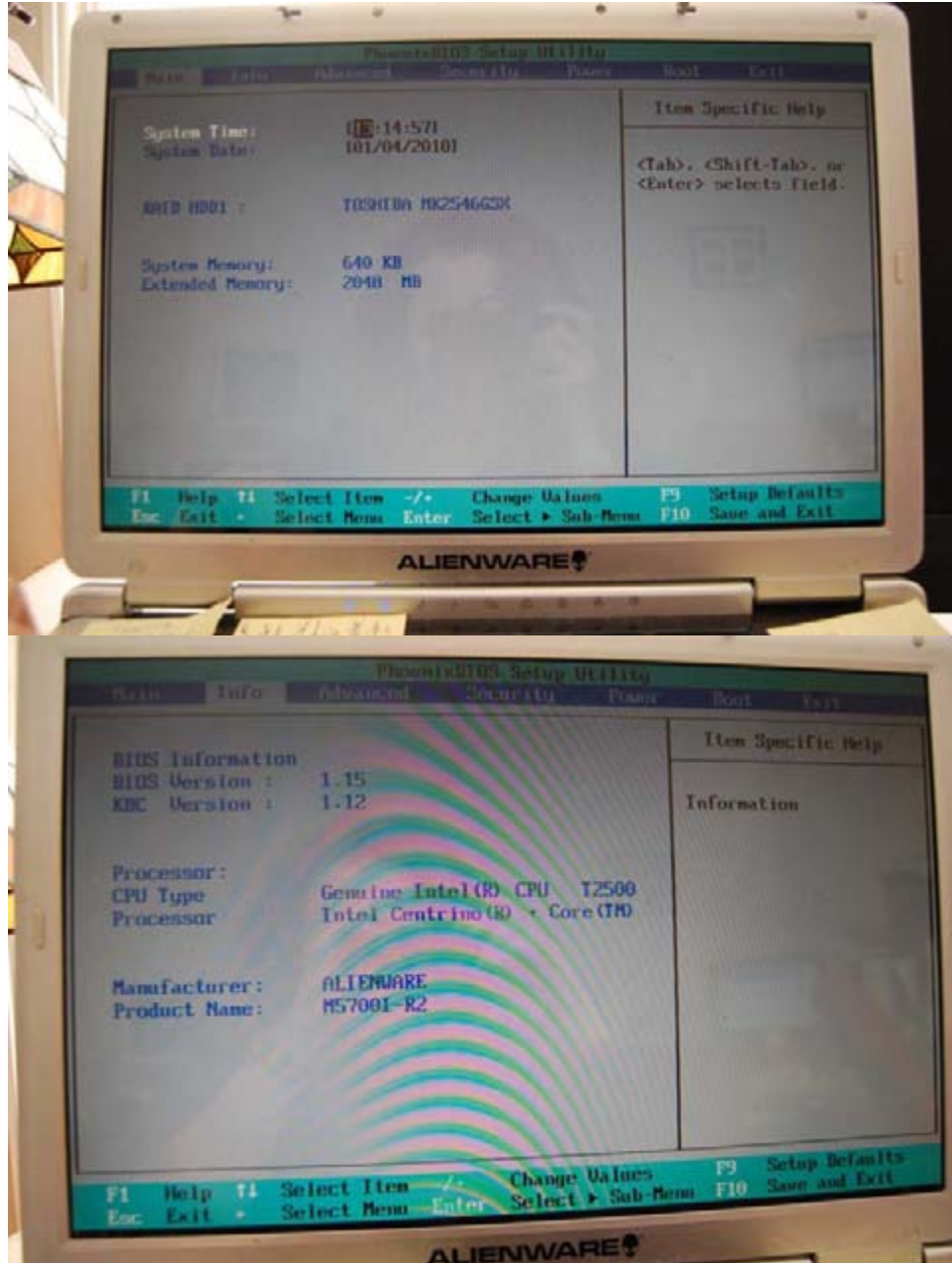
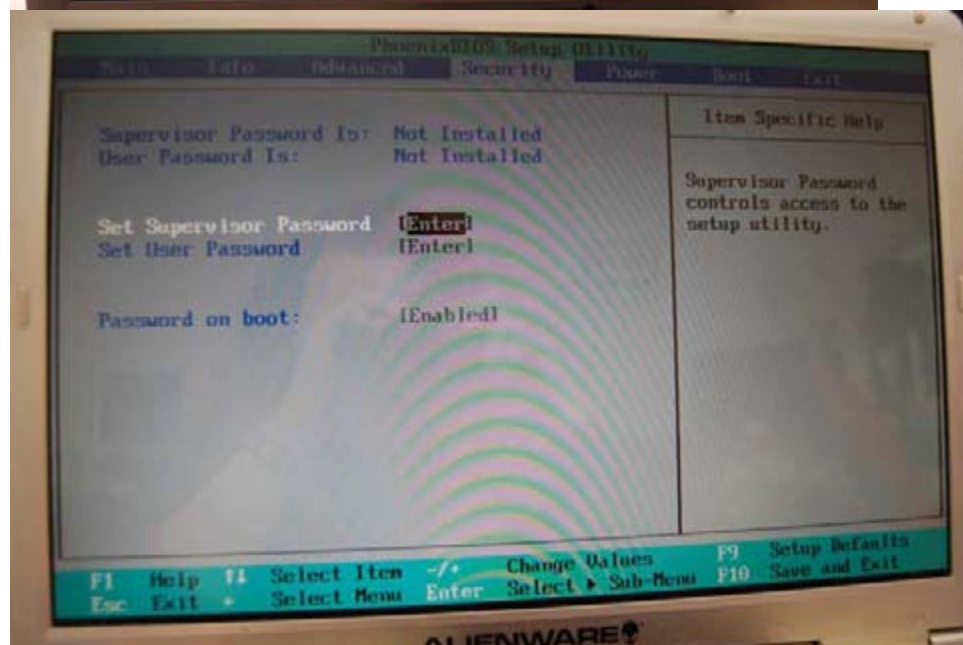
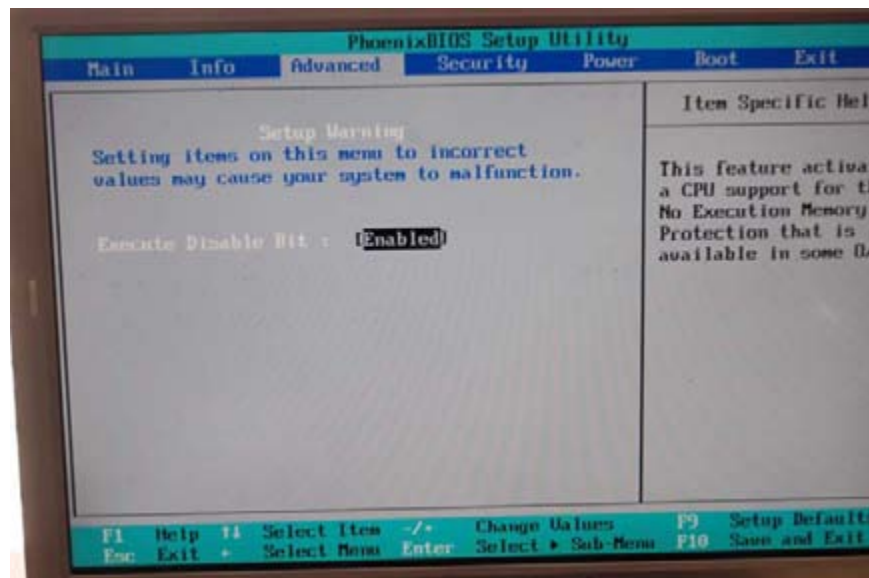
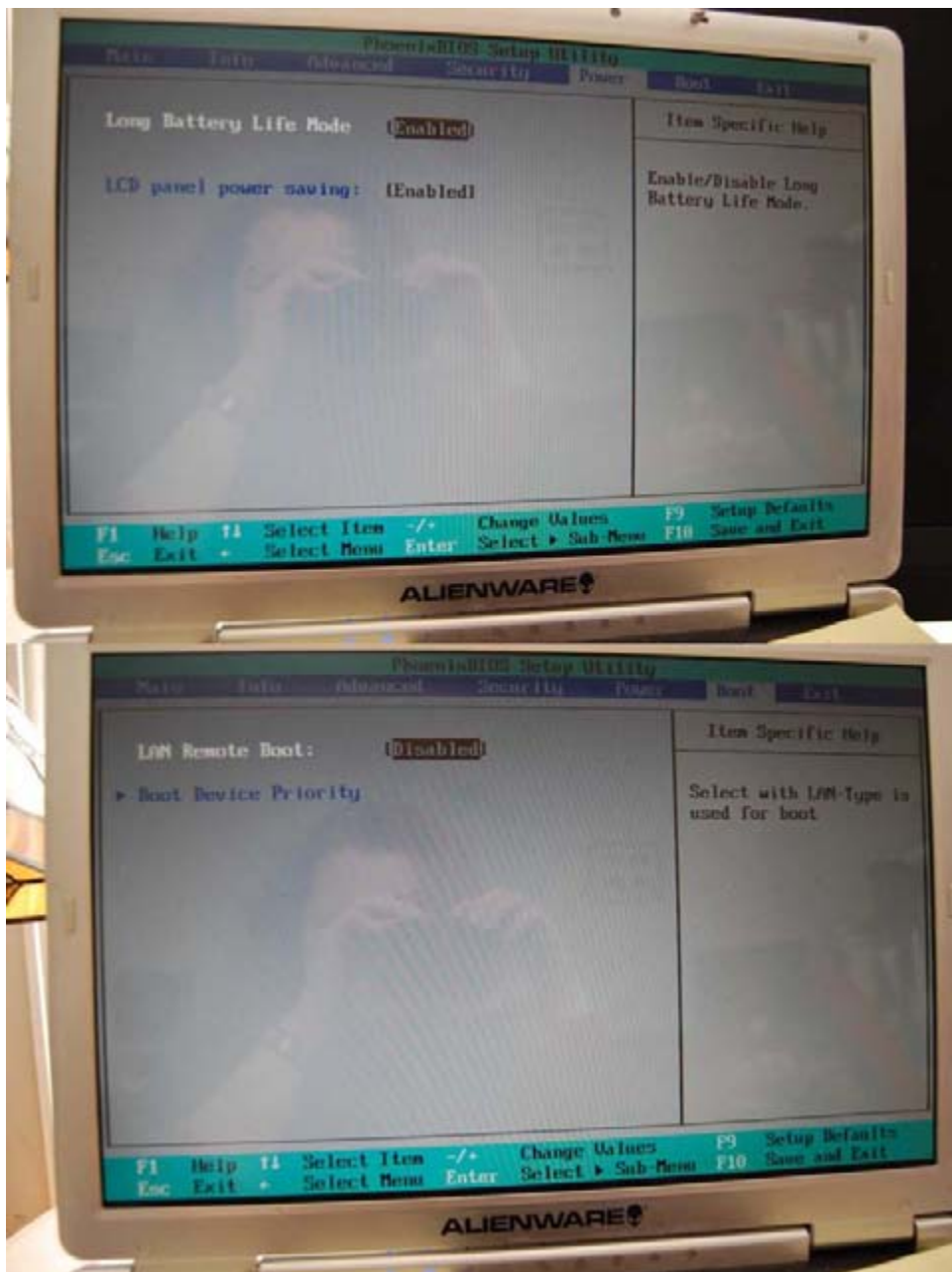


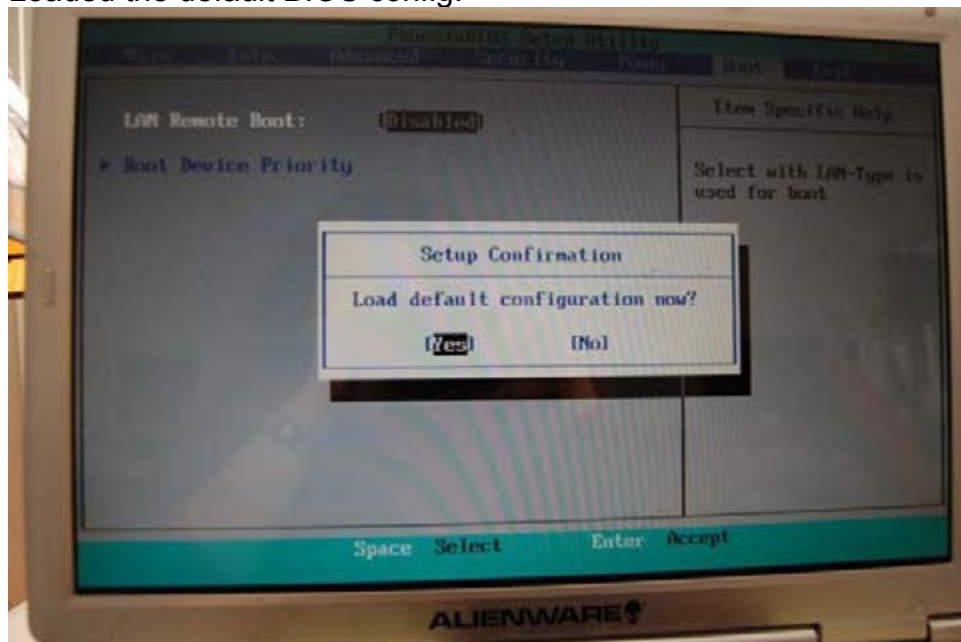
1. Go into the BIOS, showing you every tab, so you can see this BIOS is more limited than most:



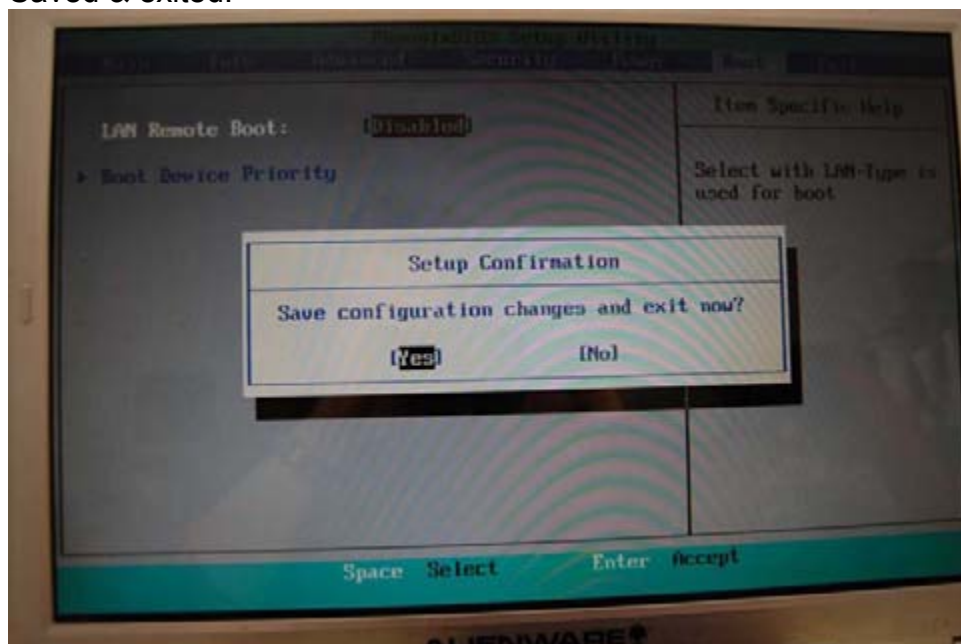




2. Loaded the default BIOS config:

5. Just to let you see, I opened the RAID utility and took a shot:

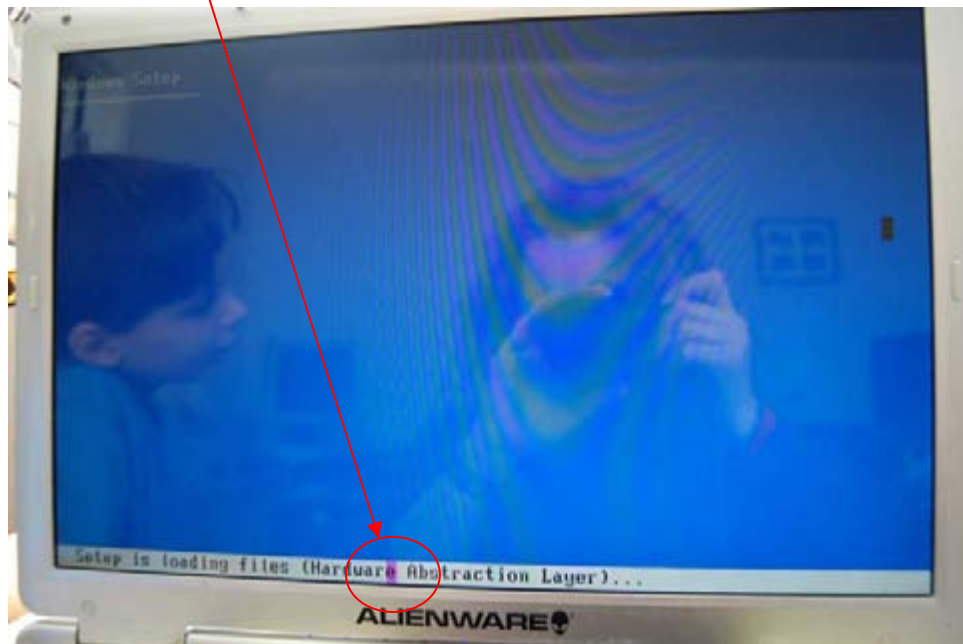


...and then immediately ESC out of it.

This is why I say RC is affected:

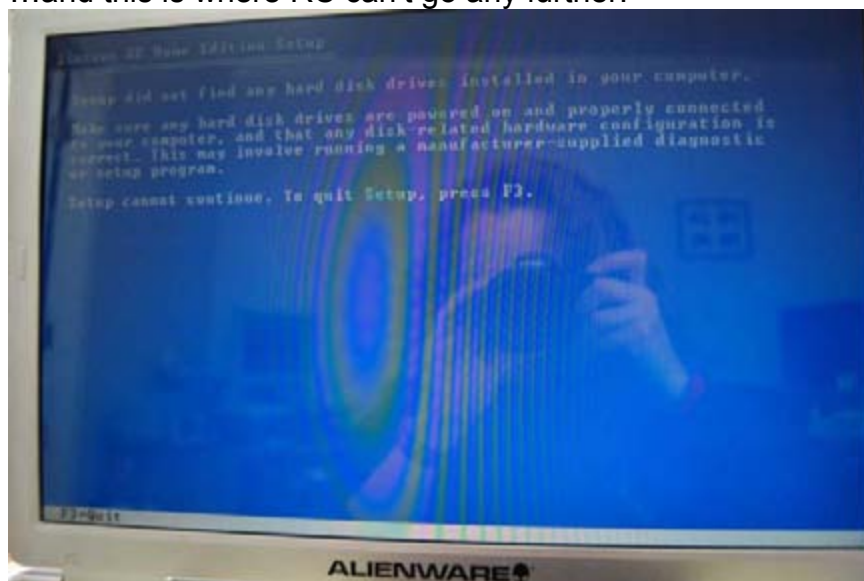
