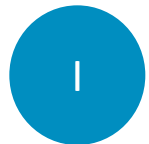

Enabling Macros in Excel 2007:

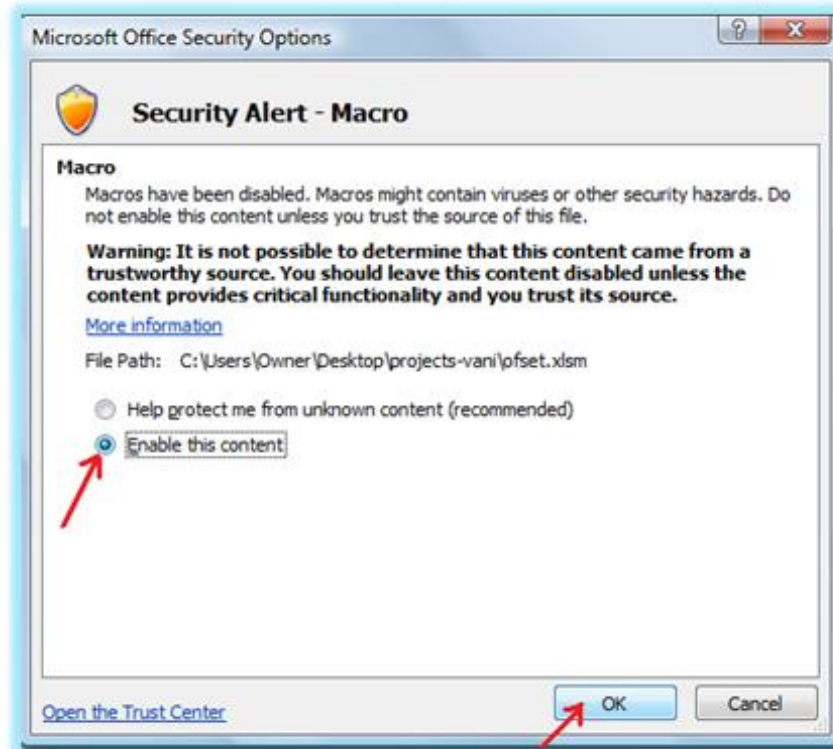

Click Options button.



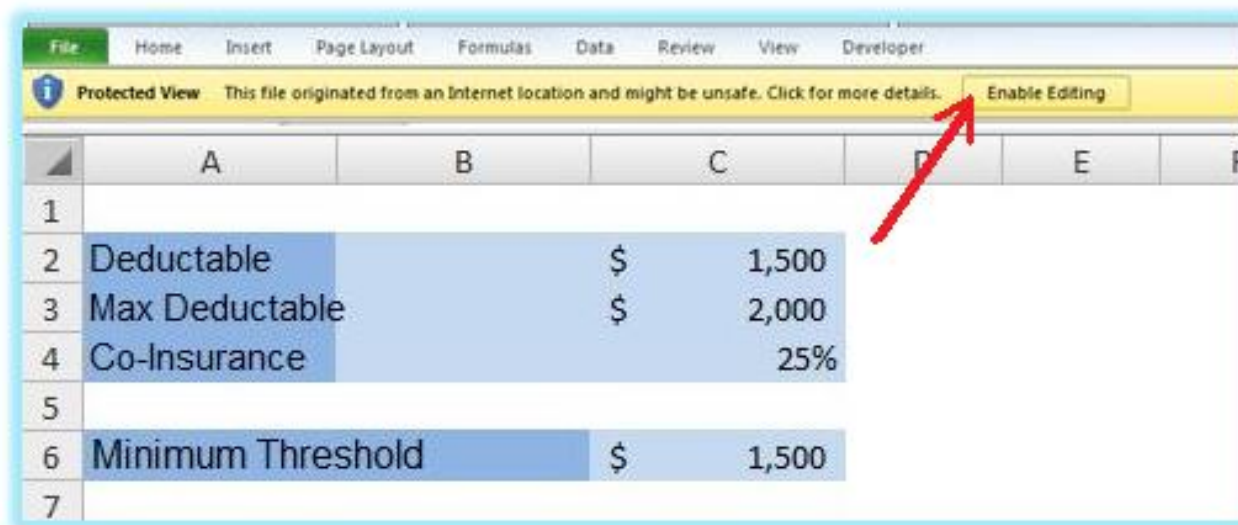
